UPDATE: REGISTRATION & LICENSING OF VEHICLES IMPORTED FROM HONG KONG

The Roads Authority (RA) wishes to inform the public that applications for the registration of imported motor vehicles from Hong Kong will be accepted and processed at all NaTIS Offices countrywide, with immediate effect.

Members of the public are, however, reminded that all applications must strictly comply with the requirements set out in Regulation 16 of the Road Traffic and Transport Regulations. In this regard, the following documents must be attached to every application for registration of a motor vehicle imported from Hong Kong:

- The Hong Kong Registration Certificate, or
- A Deregistration, Cancellation, or Export Certificate, or
- Any official document confirming the cancellation of registration issued by the relevant Hong Kong Authority.

Furthermore, full compliance with all statutory requirements governing the registration and licensing of imported motor vehicles is mandatory.

Members of the public and vehicle importers are accordingly encouraged to ensure that all required documentation are complete and accurate prior to submitting their applications, to prevent unnecessary delays in processing.

The RA wishes to express its gratitude to the public for their patience and understanding during the transition to this updated registration process. Your cooperation is highly appreciated as we work to provide efficient and compliant vehicle registration services.
